City of Champaign Employee Compensation Report

The following are the guidelines followed when compiling this report:

- The report includes all employees who received compensation between July 1, 2018 and June 30, 2019, including seasonal and temporary staff.
- The report shows the most recent position held by the employee.
- Employees are sorted into the following groups:
 - o AFSCME: American Federation of State, County, and Municipal Employees
 - o FIRE: International Association of Fire Fighters
 - o NBU: Non-bargaining unit temporary or seasonal employees
 - o NBU-DEPT HEAD: Department Heads
 - o NBU-EXEMPT: Non-bargaining unit Exempt positions (ineligible for overtime)
 - o NBU-NON EXMPT: Non-bargaining unit Non-Exempt positions (overtime eligible)
 - o PLUMBERS: United Association of Plumbers and Steamfitters
 - o POLICE: Fraternal Order of Police
- Some City employees are required to take City marked vehicles home to respond to emergencies, and require those vehicles to perform their responsibilities. Vehicle allowance amounts reflect 'personal use' amounts computed for tax purposes. There are employees who drive City vehicles who do not have a vehicle allowance reflected on this report because they did not meet the criteria for reflecting 'personal use.'
- The "Other Earnings" column may include various types of earnings, such as contractual bonuses and residency incentives.
- Health Insurance includes premiums or waivers paid by the City. It does not include the cost of health insurance premiums paid by the employee.
- The "Other Fringes" column includes the cost of taxable fringe benefits paid by the City. This column is comprised primarily of the cost of life insurance and/or disability insurance benefits.
- Fire/Police pension amounts are based on the total amount contributed to the pension fund by the City, applied proportionally to each member according to base salary.
- The Total Compensation column is the sum of Earnings, Health Insurance, Other Fringes, Pension, Social Security and Medicare.
- Loans: this category includes amounts loaned to employees under City benefits programs for various purposes, such as the purchase of a personal computer. All amounts in this category are expected to be repaid over the term of the loan, usually within 2 years.
